


Climate breakdown is not something in the future, it's here now. Already we are seeing more extreme weather events which can have a deadly impact. The number of climate disasters has **increased five-fold** over recent decades. The warmest January day ever was recorded in at least eight European countries in January 2023.

In 1950 the human world emitted 6 billion tons of Carbon Dioxide. In 2022 more than 34 billion tons of CO₂ emissions went into the atmosphere, warming the world very fast.

The density of CO₂ trapped in the atmosphere is now one-third higher than it has been in the last 10 million years.

The trapped heat is causing extreme weather events and regional climate collapse.

The Sunak Government is carrying on with Business as Usual despite declaring a climate emergency. We are living in a period of multiple crisis - debt, inflation, war, pandemic, species extinction and extreme weather - writes *Tony Staunton* from the Campaign against Climate Change.

All these challenges are linked. The climate crisis is causing:

- famine for tens of millions of people, and species extinctions
- homelessness from floods & fires, forcing migration
- failed harvests, pollinator decline and food shortages
- fuel shortages, price hikes and deepening poverty
- international competition for natural resources
- civil conflict and war for land, food and supplies
- authoritarian government to prevent protest and refuge
- Racist scapegoating of climate refugees & minorities

Governments here and across the world are continuing with policies for growth based upon maximising corporate profits and utilising taxpayers money to protect and underwrite the businesses of the super-rich, whilst cutting social infrastructure, health and welfare services.

Join the issues together

The crisis can be solved. We have all the technology we need to reduce and stop global heating emissions: wind, water and solar power to generate the energy we need, reducing the energy demand and transforming our industries to produce for people before profit.

We have to change the System if we are to survive. We already face a global average of over 2C degrees, melting glacier and polar ice, raising sea levels and devastating traditional harvests. Just as in times of world war, all industrial production and employment has to change to be geared towards self-defence - this time as coordinated international effort to save the climate we need in order to survive. Trade Unions have a huge role to play in ensuring a Just Transition to Green Jobs, protecting and retraining workforces away from fossil-fuelled industries and into home insulation, public transport systems, and ecologically sustainable food production.
